








Wood doubles at Perris MX

Texan Dee Wood posted an impressive four-moto sweep of both the 125 and 250cc Pro classes during the Women's Motorsports Association-promoted Women's MX Championships at Perris Raceway.

Wood started her day on a positive note with the holeshot in the first 125cc Pro moto. Local

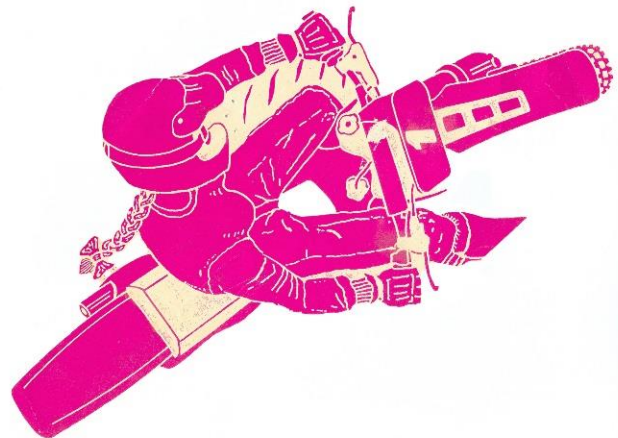
racer Tami Rice was running a strong second followed by Aussie Tiffany Greenwood, and Hawaii's Corina Chinen. Greenwood wasted little time with Rice and made her move at the start of the second lap. Greenwood was on the gas, and in less than a lap caught and began to push Wood. With the lead on the line both riders set an awesome pace and pulled away from the field. The battle continued until Greenwood bobbed and dropped back. Greenwood did manage to get back on pace but her charge came too late to be considered a serious threat. Wood motored across the line for the win followed by Greenwood, Chinen and Rice. Arizona's Diane Piper came from dead last to finish fifth.

The second moto seemed to duplicate the first, with Wood and Greenwood out front and battling. This time Piper started third but had to contend with a hard-charging Chinen. As the race wore on, Greenwood seemed to wear down and slip off pace. Wood went on for the win while Greenwood settled for second. Chinen got the best of Piper for third by virtue of a last-lap pass. Teenager Jamie Pamintuan rounded out the top five in front Rice, who raced the greater part of the second moto with a flat rear tire.

Wood was back later in the day to post a wire-to-wire win in the first 250cc Pro moto. Greenwood was once again the runner-up followed by Chinen and Piper.

Greenwood by this time must have been getting tired of playing second fiddle to Wood. At the start of the second moto she roosted off the line with the holeshot. Greenwood was blazing fast during the first part of the moto and began to open a significant lead until she fell off her motorcycle near the finish line. Wood inherited the lead and cruised to the moto and overall win. Chinen made the best of Greenwood's mishap and scored the runner-up position while Greenwood picked herself up off the ground for third.

Last year's First Timer class winner, Christine Russell, moved up to the Beginner class for this year's event. Russell smoked the pack on an 80cc machine during the first moto. Cheri Feathergill bested Laurie Schipper for second while Brenda Yancy and Julie Sokatch rounded the top five. Russell looked like she was on her way to a repeat performance in the second moto, but she fell hard at the base of the steep jump at the end of the rockers. Russell took a long time to remount and would eventually charge back for fourth behind Sokatch, Schipper and overall winner Feathergill.
